**CALL TO ORDER**

Commissioner Burke called the meeting to order at 5:08 pm at the Cottonwood Recreation Center.

**MINUTES –FEBRUARY 23, 2010 REGULAR MEETING**

Commissioner Burke asked for consideration of the minutes from the February 23, 2010 regular meeting. Commissioner Bowden motioned to approve the minutes as written. Commissioner Munn seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**A. MONTHLY REPORT INFORMATION FOR FEBRUARY 2010**

Mr. Faust asked if there were any questions on the monthly reports for February. Hearing none, he reviewed some of the information regarding revenues for the recreation center, Brian Mickelsen Memorial run/walk and adult sports.

**B. COTTONWOOD COMMUNITY RECREATION/AQUATICS CENTER – CURRENT ISSUES & UPDATES**

Mr. Faust updated the commission on the status of the recreation center construction. A & P Construction is currently working on the second half of punch-list items. He was proud to announce that the project went over 300 days without an incident. He also reviewed some of the very positive comments that visitors have shared about the new facility.

**C. OLD AQUATICS CENTER UPDATE**

Mr. Faust reviewed the construction schedule for the existing pool. Construction was delayed some over the past month due to rain but the contractors feel they will be finished by June 1, which is almost a month early. If that happens, he expects the pool to be open to the public by June 15.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**A. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE – 9.12 OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC PEACE, SECTION 9.12.030 – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

Mr. Faust reviewed the amendment to the ordinance dealing with alcoholic beverages. This change would allow beer and wine consumption in the Civic Center and the Cottonwood Recreation Center Community Events Hall. It will also make it so the department does not have to get special permission from Council every year to have alcohol at Rhythm & Ribs held at the Cottonwood Kid's Park.

After discussing this new opportunity and the process for being able to sell spirits, Mr. Faust read the changes to the ordinance as written in the Council Communications that goes to the next Council meeting of April 6.
