**CALL TO ORDER**

Commissioner Hulse called the meeting to order at 5:01 pm at the Cottonwood Recreation Center Conference Room.

**MINUTES – SEPTEMBER 23, 2014 REGULAR MEETING**

Commissioner Hulse asked for consideration of the minutes from the September 23 regular meeting. Commissioner Bowden motioned to approve the minutes as written. Commissioner Nielsen seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**A. MONTHLY REPORT INFORMATION FOR SEPTEMBER 2014**

Mr. Faust commented that the total number of CRC members and revenues were up again compared to September 2012 and 2013. He asked if there were any questions on the monthly reports from September. There were none.

**B. RECREATION CENTER MONTHLY UTILITY USE AND ANALYSIS (THROUGH SEPTEMBER)**

Mr. Faust reviewed the utility charges through September.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**A. THUNDER VALLEY RALLY AND RHYTHM & RIBS RECAP WITH CITY COUNCIL – COUNCIL DIRECTION**

Mr. Faust and Mr. Allen reviewed the presentation they made to City Council regarding the two large signature events. After nine years, Rhythm & Ribs has not been growing in participation nor continuing to bring people in to the community even though there is still a lot of popular local support for the event. After hearing all of the information, Council's direction was to discontinue the Rhythm & Ribs and split funding between next year's Thunder Valley Rally while assisting the Page Springs Cellars event, Tilted Earth Festival.

The commissioners were disappointed that Rhythm & Ribs would no longer be run by the city but they understood.

**B. UPCOMING RECREATION CENTER ANNUAL CLOSURE – CENTER PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE AND UPKEEP**

Mr. Faust stated that approximately \$16,000 in preventative maintenance and upkeep would occur during the recreation center's annual weeklong closure. He reviewed the main items to be fixed, replaced or cleaned which included gymnasium lights, parking lot bumpers, windows, carpets, and tiling.

**C. RECREATION CENTER WATER FEATURE PLAY APPARATUS – REPAIRS TO BUCKET SYSTEM**

Mr. Faust stated that two of the buckets on the large play unit in the indoor pool have not worked well since installation. As it is still under warranty, they are being replaced.

**D. UPCOMING PARKS & RECREATION PROGRAMS/SPECIAL EVENTS**

Mr. Faust reviewed the upcoming programs and special events, which included the Fall Carnival and Walkin' on Main.
