**ASRS 38-844. Requirements for retirement benefits and disability pensions H.** An ordinary disability pension shall be reduced in the period before the member's normal retirement date if the member engages in any employment and if the member's income from this employment is greater than the member's pension unreduced by this subsection. The amount of the reduction shall be equal to the difference between the member's income from employment and the member's unreduced pension. The local board shall have the right to suspend payments of an ordinary disability pension if the disabled member fails to report earned income. Such suspension shall be for the period there is no satisfactory report with restoration of benefits on acceptance of such report or until the member's normal retirement date, whichever occurs earlier. If, in the opinion of the local board, the reduction provided in this subsection is insufficient to recover monies previously paid to a member, each local board, in its sole discretion, may bring an action to recover any outstanding balance due, notwithstanding any other rights the local board possesses.
