OLD BUSINESS

UPDATE OF NACOG'S WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM

Chairperson Bremner was able to provide some additional information from NACOG. They informed her that \$7.5 M has been designated for the program for four counties, which include Yavapai. 45% will be used in the second year, and 45% will be spent in the third year. They estimate 1600 homes will be weatherized. The average cost per home will be \$7,000. There are 47 homes in Yavapai County that have been completed, 40 in progress, and a total of 120 applications.

UPDATE ON FINDING A LOCATION FOR THE PRIME TIME FAIR

Chairperson Bremner invited Ryan Bigelow, who works at the new Cottonwood Recreation Center, to provide information about the Center..

Mr. Bigelow informed the Commission of the different areas of the Center and what activities are to be provided in the areas. He was ask if the gym could be used for a Prime Time Fair. He said the gym should work well for such an event.

After Mr. Bigelow left, there was further discussion regarding a Prime Time Fair. It was the consensus of the Commission members that the plans should move forward with planning a Prime Time Fair for the spring of 2011.

The Commission will discuss possible vendors and sponsors at the next meeting.
