ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF

POSSIBLE REGULATION OR BANNING THE USE OF CONSUMER FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

Fire Chief Casson and Fire Inspector Contreras gave a Power Point presentation on the new law that would go into effect on December 1, 2010, which allows for the sale and use of certain permissible consumer fireworks. Their recommendation was for the Council to adopt an ordinance banning the use of consumer fireworks within the city limits for safety reasons.

The Council directed staff to proceed with writing an ordinance banning the use of consumer fireworks within the city limits.

DISCUSSION REGARDING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE, SECTION 304 (DESIGN REVIEW) AND SECTION 404.H. PERTAINING TO HEIGHT REGULATIONS

The Council directed staff to write an ordinance amending the Zoning Ordinance to update the height regulations for various types of structures that are not covered by the existing Zoning Ordinance.
