

SUMMARY MINUTES
OF THE WORK SESSION OF THE COTTONWOOD CITY COUNCIL HELD OCTOBER 8, 2013,
HELD AT 5:00 P.M., AT THE COTTONWOOD COUNCIL CHAMBERS LOCATED AT 826 NORTH
MAIN STREET, COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA.

PRESENTATION REGARDING THE VERDE RIVER BLUE TRAIL

The Council heard a presentation from Doug Von Guasig, on the Verde River Blue Trail plan. He asked the Council for a letter of support for the Blue Trail plan.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF:

CITY RECOGNITION OF CIVIL UNIONS/DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIPS FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES

The Council reviewed with staff the ordinances from other cities and towns relating to civil unions and directed staff to bring it back at a regular meeting for consideration.

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING ISLAND IN OLD TOWN

Staff presented a plan for a traffic calming island to be placed at the south end of old town on Main Street. The council directed staff to ensure that it would continue with the theme of the archway that is being built for the jail trail and look for an old fashioned speed regulatory sign.

LOCATION FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW CITY HALL

Staff and Council discussed the location for the new city hall should be, and Council directed staff to look at the possibility of buying or trading for the property on the north end of Old Town and bring back some cost estimates of how much it will cost to purchase the property and build a new city hall at a future work session for further discussion.
