

SUMMARY REPORT

OF COUNCIL ACTION TAKEN AT THE NOVEMBER 16, 2010, SPECIAL MEETING HELD AT 5:00 PM AT THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS BUILDING, 826 NORTH MAIN STREET, COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA.

This summary is a statement of legal actions taken by the Cottonwood City Council at a special meeting pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02(D.), and is being provided as required by A.R.S. § 38-431.01(D.).

PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING POTENTIAL PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

A public hearing regarding potential projects to be considered for the funding available to the city through the Community Development Block Grant program for fiscal year 2011-2012 was held.

Charlie Scully, long-term planner for the city's Community Development Department stated he spoke to Kelly Byrd, branch director of the Cottonwood Boys & Girls Club, who could not be present tonight, but indicated interest in submitting an idea for the Boys & Girls Club for help with some programs that benefited low-income children.

The Council indicated interest in the redevelopment of 4th Street in Old Town and 10th street from Main to Mingus,

Carol Quasula, representing Catholic Charities, stated they were interested in obtaining funding to improve the Catholic Charities building and increase their office space.

City Manager Doug Bartosh, stated if a new City Hall was built it might affect the Boys & Girls Club building in Old Town, and there had been some discussion regarding moving them to the old fire department building which would require some renovation to accommodate them. CDBG funds would be requested to renovate the old fire department building for use as the Boys & Girls Club.

George Gehlert, community development director for the city, mentioned the re-alignment of the intersection of 10th Street and Main as part of the redevelopment of the 10th Street from Main to Mingus project mentioned.
