**ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF:**

**UPDATE FROM THE COTTONWOOD YOUTH ADVISORY COMMISSION REGARDING ITS EVENTS AND SERVICE PROJECTS**

Members of the Youth Commission reviewed the projects and events the commission had participated in for the past three month period.

Vice Mayor Pfeifer and Council Member Norman presented Hezekiah Allen, Aquatics/Special Events Supervisor, a plaque of appreciation for his work with the Youth Commission.

**DIRECTION REGARDING THE OLD MAINTENANCE BUILDING LOCATED BEHIND THE CIVIC CENTER**

The Council directed staff to proceed with the demolition of the old vacated maintenance building located behind the Civic Center.

**PROPOSED PARKING LOT AND PARK IN OLD TOWN (FORMERLY GARDNER'S RECYCLING AREA)**

The Council directed staff to proceed with the parking lot project on the north side of Yavapai Street which will add 45 regular, 3 handicap, and 7 motorcycle parking spaces.

**COMMUNITY GARDEN—UPDATE, GARDEN METHOD, PROPOSED FEES AND REGULATIONS**

The Council directed staff to implement new rules and regulations for the community garden adding a stipulation that no railroad ties or tires were allowed in the garden; the garden be organic; implementing a \$25 fee for a 16 x 16 foot plot for an individual/family and \$75 for a business and/or for business use; and reserving the south side of the garden for Square Foot Gardening boxes.
