

SUMMARY REPORT
OF THE COTTONWOOD CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL WORK SESSION HELD MARCH 28, 2013, AT 6:00 P.M., AT THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS BUILDING, 826 N. MAIN STREET, COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF:

OLD TOWN JAIL PARKING LOT PLAN

Council and Staff discussed what to do with a proposed parking lot near the Old Town Jail that will stretch into what was known as the Gardner Property at the north end of Old Town.

After discussion, Council directed staff to remove the proposed motorcycle spaces in front of the Old Town Jail to make room for a pedestrian walkway towards the Old Jail Trail, a kiosk promoting the trail and the Verde River, signage promoting access to the Verde River and trail and prepare a new plan for consideration by the Council at a future meeting.
