RESOLUTION NUMBER 2587—APPOINTING THE PRESIDING MAGISTRATE FOR THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL COURT & CONSIDERATION OF AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

Judge LaSota reviewed his accomplishments during his two-year tenure as magistrate for the city's municipal court.

The Council convened into executive session and after reconvening back into special session, approved Resolution Number 2587, with a dissenting vote by Council Member Elinski, appointing Mr. LaSota to another two-year term as city magistrate and increasing his salary to \$89,250 annually.
