**DEPARTMENTAL BUDGETS**

Interim Fire Chief Mike Kuykendall reviewed the fire department's accomplishments for the current fiscal year and its goals and proposed budget for fiscal year 2012-13.

Police Chief Jody Fanning, reviewed the accomplishments for the police department, animal control, and communications department for the current fiscal year and the departmental budgets for fiscal year 2012-13.

Casey Rooney, Community Development Director, reviewed the accomplishments for the economic development department for the current fiscal year and the department budget for fiscal year 2012-2013.

Richard Faust, Community Services General Manager, reviewed the accomplishments for the following departments: parks and recreation, recreation center, cemetery, custodial, library, pool and Cottonwood Area Transit/Verde Lynx Systems. He then reviewed the proposed 2012-13 budgets for each department.

Rudy Rodriguez, Administrative Services General Manager, reviewed the accomplishments for the municipal court for the current fiscal year and the court's budget for fiscal year 2012-2013.
