OF THE COTTONWOOD CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION HELD MAY 8, 2012, AT 6:00 P.M., AT
THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS BUILDING, 826 NORTH MAIN STREET, COTTONWOOD,
ARIZONA.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF:

POSSIBLE REDUCTION OF SPEED LIMIT ON 6TH STREET BETWEEN MINGUS AVENUE AND SR 89A

Council and staff discussed lowering the speed limit on 6th Street between Mingus Avenue and SR 89A from 35 mph to 25 mph.

Council directed staff to lower the speed in the most expedient and efficient way possible.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE TO LIMIT "THROUGH" TRUCK TRAFFIC ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS AND THE PORTION OF MAIN STREET IN OLD TOWN

Council and staff discussed possible means to lower through truck traffic on residential streets and Old Town. Staff has recommended creating a truck route and permitting system within city limits with regular deliveries within city limits being exempt.

Council has directed staff to start drafting an Ordinance and bring it back on a future work session for further discussion.
