

SUMMARY REPORT
OF THE COTTONWOOD CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION HELD JULY 12, 2011, AT 6:00 P.M.,
AT THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS BUILDING, 826 NORTH MAIN STREET, COTTONWOOD,
ARIZONA.

This summary is a statement of direction given by the Cottonwood City Council at a Work Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02(D.), and is being provided as required by A.R.S. § 38-431.01(D.).

Council Members Present: Mayor Diane Joens, Vice Mayor Karen Pfeifer, Council Members Jesse Dowling, Tim Elinski, Ruben Jauregui, Linda Norman, and Terence Pratt.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF:

DESIGN OF THE 12th STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT FROM FIR STREET TO SR 89A

Staff presented three areas they wanted direction on for the 12th Street reconstruction project. One was a proposal to narrow 12th Street to encourage motorists to travel at a slower speed. The next was installing new sewer lines for the residents. And third, to move the existing electrical lines underground. Staff informed the Council it could have a preliminary plan done within 60 days.

Council directed staff to prepare a preliminary plan with a narrowed street that would include moving the electrical lines underground but not installing new sewer lines for the residents. The plan would include space for future sewer lines.
