

SUMMARY REPORT
OF THE COTTONWOOD CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION HELD AUGUST 14, 2012, AT 6:00 P.M., AT THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS BUILDING, 826 NORTH MAIN STREET, COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA.

This summary is a statement of direction given by the Cottonwood City Council at a Work Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02(D.), and is being provided as required by A.R.S. § 38-431.01(D.).

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF:

EXPANSION OF THE OLD TOWN HOLIDAY LIGHT PROGRAM AND REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM FROM THE COUNCIL'S CONTINGENCY FUND

Staff requested \$5,000 from the Council's Contingency Fund to increase the holiday light display in old town. The total price for the city would \$15,000.

Council directed staff to bring this item forward on a regular meeting.

RELOCATION OF THE COTTONWOOD DOG PARK FACILITY

Council and staff discussed possible solutions for the dog park. Staff has received complaints related to the dog park at Riverfront Park. Staff has identified three possible locations as well as a possible wall being built at Riverfront Park.

Council directed staff to hold a special work session to discuss this further as well as provided the Council with cost information for either moving the park or building a wall.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE BY ADDING NEW SECTIONS FOR HILLSIDE AND WASH DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS

Council and staff discussed adding possible hillside and wash development standards to the zoning code for Cottonwood.

Council directed staff to continue to work on a possible ordinance for the zoning code.
