PRELIMINARY DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF REGARDING WATER RATE ADJUSTMENTS

Rudy Rodriguez, Administrative Services General Manager, discussed with the Council the possible adjustments to the current water rates. The Council discussed with Mr. Rodriguez the possibilities involving having enough revenue funds to cover the bond covenants of 135% of the interest and principal; provide different rates between commercial and residential properties; a gradual rate increase over several years; and creating additional tiers.

Mr. Rodriguez will investigate those areas and provide more information for discussion at a future Work Session.
