TRASH COLLECTION AND RECYCLING SERVICES

Council directed staff to schedule a work session to further discuss trash collection within the city, and negotiate for the least cost for the recycling services with a shorter duration for the contract period.

PRESENTATION ON THE HISTORICAL AND CURRENT BASE FLOWS OF THE VERDE RIVER

Tom Whitmer, Water Resources Administrator, made a presentation on the historical flows of the Verde River with an in depth analysis of the measured flows at four different USGS gaging stations.

UPDATE REGARDING THE DESIGN OF THE CITY'S NEW EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS CENTER

Scott Mangarpan, Project Manager, and Kyle Swanson a representative from Arrington Watkins Architects, gave the council an update on new emergency communications center building project.
