

TESTING FOR POLICE OFFICER POSITION

All applicants are invited to test for the Police Officer position. Testing will take place at the Cottonwood Police Department, 199 South 6th Street, Cottonwood, Arizona, on Friday, July 10, 2009, promptly at 7:00 AM.

At 7:00 AM you will begin with stretch and warm up for the physical fitness test portion that will begin promptly at 7:30 AM, so come dressed in appropriate clothing for physical fitness testing. If you pass the physical fitness test portion you will then move on to the written exam. You will be given time to change into appropriate dress before the test begins. The written test will consist of a multiple choice and two (2) essay questions, which will be on two of the three following topics: "Bill of Rights", "Ethics/Integrity", and/or "Cultural Diversity". Those passing the written exam will proceed to the oral board.

Please bring the "Applicant Informed Consent Waiver Form" with you when you come for testing. The physical fitness information is included in the application packet if you picked one up from the Human Resources Department, 816 N. Main Street, Cottonwood, Arizona, or at the City of Cottonwood's web site, www.ci.cottonwood.az.us.

The Police Department also has a study guide for the multiple choice portion of the test. You may purchase the booklet for \$15.00 or you can preview it at the Police Department, 199 S. 6th Street, Cottonwood, Arizona, between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday.
