

PUBLIC NOTICE

Prescott National Forest and Community Partners are exploring development of a large Recreation Area near the “old dump” adjacent to FR493 SW of the Cottonwood Airport.

Currently, the public predominantly uses the Site for informal dispersed recreational firearms shooting and illegal dumping.

The Forest Service investigated the Site for the possible contamination through its authorities under the Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA).

This site is Scheduled for remediation under CERCLA in Mid-January 2017.

A proposed Forest Order will restrict public entry and recreational shooting in the remediated areas and prohibit shooting in areas adjacent to the site during and after remediation activities.

An informational public meeting is scheduled for November 3, 2016 to discuss the Recreation Area Proposal, CERCLA Action and Proposed Area and Shooting Closures.
