The Cottonwood Public Library is happy to announce a free, weekly Spanish class every Tuesday from 2 to 3 p.m. starting on May 31st. The class will be an informal and personalized approach to learning Spanish. Unlike a college class, you can go at your own pace and learn what you want to. You have the freedom of focusing on oral communication, written communication or both. One of the really neat things about this class is that you can focus on Spanish for a particular purpose.
