Trespassing call leads to Warrant Arrest

On January 2, 2016, at about 6:25 PM, 56 year old Michael Scott Travis was arrested on a Flagstaff Warrant after Officers were called to a home in the 300 block of S. 17th Street for a report of Trespassing. According to Police Reports the owner of the property said he was renting to a female subject on a month to month basis but she had missed her December payment and had since moved out. According to the property owner the female's son, Michael Travis, was still living in the residence even though he had never been on the lease. When Officers contacted Travis they discovered he had an outstanding warrant for his arrest out of the Flagstaff JP. Travis was taken into custody and transported to the Yavapai County Jail.



Donation Box Stolen from Circle K

On January 2, 2016, Cottonwood Police took a report of a theft of a donation box for "United Cerebral Palsy" from the Circle K the previous night. According to reports the box was taken at about 8:50 PM the previous night by a male subject wearing a black baseball cap, white shirt and a black jacket. The male subject is observed on video surveillance taking the box from the counter and placing it inside his jacket before exiting the store. It was estimated approximately \$50.00 in cash was taken from the donation box. Anyone with information on the theft is asked to call the Cottonwood Police Department.
