### Cottonwood Police seeking the Public's Help

Cottonwood Police are asking the public's help regarding 2 different cases they are currently working. Anyone with information is asked to contact the Cottonwood Police Department Criminal Investigations Division at 928-634-4246 or Yavapai Silent Witness at 1-800-932-3232.

On October 24, 2015, at about 11:43 PM, Cottonwood Police responded to call of a vehicle fire in the area of East Aspen and S 15<sup>th</sup> Street. The vehicle in question sustained moderate damage to the front driver's side window and hood and the driver's side bumper. It appeared that gasoline had been poured over the vehicle prior to it getting caught on fire.
