### **Cottonwood Area Transit Will Be Changing Fare Structure beginning July 1, To Provide More Options For Seniors and Students**

As passed in the April 15, 2014 City of Cottonwood Council Meeting, effective July 1, 2014, all seniors age 60 and older and all students with a valid student ID card will be able to ride the CAT and Lynx buses for half price. What this means is that fares for qualifying seniors and students on CAT buses will be \$0.50 per ride and on Lynx buses fares will be \$1.00. All passes will also be half price and seniors and students are encouraged to purchase passes for their convenience. Seniors will have to provide proof of age and students will have to provide a current or, if summer, recent, valid school ID in order to get the reduced rates. Passes are available for purchase at the Verde Valley Transit Facility, Cottonwood Recreation Center, Cottonwood Library, and Cottonwood Finance Office. Passes are also be available at the City of Sedona Finance office. Contact the CAT office at (928) 634-2287 for more information.

Cottonwood Area Transit provides ADA Paratransit and four fixed routes serving Cottonwood, Clarkdale and Verde Villages, with intercity commuter service to Sedona via Verde Lynx.
