### **Main & Mingus intersection - Audio Pedestrian Signals**

Audio Pedestrian Signals (APS) have been installed at the intersection of Main Street and Mingus Ave in Cottonwood. These devices assist the visually impaired when crossing an intersection by producing a “chirp” or “cuckoo” sound when it is safe to cross the intersection. The “chirp” sounds is for the north-south cross walks and the “cuckoo” is for the east-west cross walks.

This is the only traffic signal maintained by the City of Cottonwood and city staff is working with ADOT to possibly install Audio Pedestrian Signals at the ADOT controlled intersections.
