### **Public Meeting June 27 CAT/LYNX Returning to the City Effective July 1, 2012**

The City of Cottonwood, in conjunction with the cities of Clarkdale and Sedona, has decided to end its relationship with Northern Arizona Intergovernmental Transportation Authority (NAIPTA) and return CAT and LYNX operations to the City. To this end, the City has hired a transportation manager to oversee the bus operations. A public meeting will be held Wednesday, June 27, from 6:00 p.m.- 7:00 p.m. in the Cottonwood Room at the Cottonwood Recreation Center, 150 South 6th Street, Cottonwood, Arizona 86326.

CAT provides two fixed routes serving Cottonwood, Clarkdale and Verde Village, as well as Paratransit service to accommodate ADA eligible Dial-a-Ride users. LYNX provides commuter service between the cities of Cottonwood and Sedona 8 times a day, seven days a week.
