

### Summer Reading Program 2012

### Registration Information

#### Juvenile Program:

1. Fill out Registration form, front and back.
2. Get age appropriate bag.
3. Fill out the Reading Log for every half hour of reading. Two hours of reading equals one prize book. (Max. one per week!)
4. Bring in your reading log for us to stamp.
5. If you have more than four stamps in one week, you will be eligible for the monthly raffle AND for a chance to attend the Pool Party at the end of the summer!

#### Teen Program:

1. Fill out Registration form, front and back.
2. Get a teen bag.
3. Fill out the reading log for every one hour of reading. Four hours of reading equals one prize book. (Max. one per week!)
4. Bring in your reading log for us to stamp.
5. If you have more than four stamps in one week, you are eligible for the monthly raffle AND for a chance to attend the Pool Party at the end of the summer!
