INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CVS/CAREMARK PRESCRIPTION COVERAGE

CVS/Caremark ID Cards:

- New ID cards should be arriving in the mail prior to July 1, 2017.
- ID cards are typically sent in nondescript envelopes, so please watch carefully for these items.
- If you do not receive your ID cards by July 1st please note this will not affect your coverage.
- You may use your existing CVS/Caremark card information.
- Please do not destroy your current ID card until you have received the new card.

*Important: Please **REFILL YOUR PRESCRIPTIONS**
in order to avoid any issues with your medication supply.*

Additional information:

- Don't forget that deductibles reset July 1st. Members with high deductible health plans may see an adjustment in their prescription costs until the new deductibles have been met.
- CVS/Caremark makes periodic changes to their formulary drug list. You can find a complete list of formulary exclusions at <http://info.caremark.com/druglist>.
