Mayor Hahn stated that Officer Robert Taylor of the Police Department and Betsy Johnston of the Library had resigned and applications were being accepted to fill those vacancies.

AIRPORT/INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE - Councilman Snyder, Chairman, stated that the Town had received one proposal for the development of the airport industrial property. He further stated that after clarification of certain items in the proposal, a meeting would be held with all those concerned to work out final details for a development agreement.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE - Councilman Brown, Chairman, was not present at the meeting. Kevin Dunlap stated that bids for the Community Development Block Grant for street improvements would be accepted until March 30 and that actual work should begin around April 15. The Town Manager stated that bids were being accepted for a street sweeper for the Town and that bids would be opened on March 23, 1983, at which time a recommendation would be made to the Council.

LIBRARY COMMITTEE - Mayor Hahn, Chairman, stated a luncheon had been held honoring 42 library volunteers who worked 150 hours per week at the Library.

POLICE COMMITTEE - Vice-Mayor Bridgewater, Chairman, stated he had nothing new to report. Chief Keltner stated that the P.A.L. Basketball Tournament had been a great success.

PLANNING AND ZONING COMMITTEE - Councilman Moen, Chairman, stated the Public Hearing on the Proposed Zoning Ordinance and Map had been continued at the Planning and Zoning Commission Meeting on February 28, 1983, and a recommendation would be presented to the Council.

RECREATION COMMITTEE - Councilman Lewis, Chairman, stated a meeting had been held the previous week with the Parks and Recreation Commission. He further stated that they had discussed the possibility of hiring a Parks and Recreation Director and the Parks and Recreation Commission had decided to wait on their recommendation to disband, pending the upcoming budget sessions.

FIRE COMMITTEE - Councilman Wills, Chairman, stated that 97 people had been trained at the hospital in the use of fire extinguishers. Councilman Wills complemented the Fire Department on their speedy response to a recent fire call.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

PROPOSED ZONING ORDINANCE AND MAP

Mayor Hahn opened the floor for comments. He stated that a Public Hearing on the matter would be held on March 28, 1983, at which time a final vote will be taken by the Council. As there were no comments, Mayor Hahn moved to continue the matter until March 28, 1983. Motion was seconded by Councilman Snyder and carried unanimously.
