MINUTES

Councilman Moen moved to approve the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of March 8, 1983, the Minutes of the Special Meeting of March 28, 1983 and the Minutes of the Executive Session of March 28, 1983. Motion was seconded by Councilman Wills and carried unanimously.

CALL TO PUBLIC

At this time Mayor Hahn presented a plaque to Martin Colvin who had served for the past five years on the Planning and Zoning Commission for the Town. Mr. Colvin had resigned due to his moving out of town.

REPORTS BY OFFICERS

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE - Mayor Hahn, Chairman, stated that David Bishop, who has had prior experience with the Scottsdale Police Department, had been hired as a police officer for the Town.

AIRPORT/INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE - Councilman Snyder, Chairman, was not present at the meeting. The Town Manager stated that revised proposals for the development of the airport/industrial park should be forthcoming in the next few days, at which time a special meeting would be scheduled with the Council and the developers to discuss the proposals. The Town Manager further stated that specifications for the fencing grant at the airport would be submitted in the very near future and then be presented to the Arizona Department of Transportation for approval.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE - Councilman Brown, Chairman, stated that preliminary work was being done on 12th Street for preparation of necessary repairs and that a culvert had been ordered to replace the small one presently under Cochise Street.
