NOTICE OF INTENT TO IMPOSE NEW/INCREASED RATES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE CITY'S BUILDING AND SAFETY DIVISION; FIRE AND MEDICAL DEPARTMENT; ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT; AND PLANNING & ZONING DIVISION; AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-499.15, the City of Cottonwood hereby gives notice that it may adopt new/increased rates, fees and charges for the City's Building and Safety Division; Fire and Medical Department; Engineering Department; and Planning and Zoning Division.

Reports and/or schedules detailing the proposed new/increased rates, fees and charges, including supporting documentation is available at the office of the Cottonwood City Clerk, 824 N. Main Street, Cottonwood, Arizona, and on the City's website, <https://cottonwoodaz.gov>.

A public hearing on the proposed new/increased rates, fees and charges will be held during the regular meeting of the Cottonwood City Council on May 7, 2019, beginning at 6 p.m. at the Cottonwood City Council Chambers, 826 North Main Street, Cottonwood, Arizona, at which time the first reading of an Ordinance to adopt the proposed new/increased rates, fees and charges may also occur.

A second public hearing, followed by the possible approval of the Ordinance adopting the proposed new/increased rates, fees and charges is scheduled to take place at the regular meeting of the Cottonwood City Council on May 21, 2019, beginning at 6 p.m. at the Cottonwood City Council Chambers, 826 North Main Street, Cottonwood, Arizona. If approved, the new and/or increased rates, fees and charges would take effect no less than thirty days following that date. Our anticipated implementation date is July 1, 2019.
